

## 1. Klauzula dla prelegentów

### **Information on processing of personal data**

Pursuant to the provisions of Art. 13 and 26 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (hereinafter abbreviated : "GDPR") we would like to inform you that the SGH Warsaw School of Economics and FKA process your personal data as Joint Controllers, in connection with the joint organization of the Polish-German project "New challenges for the social market economy in Poland and Germany between the economic and digital transformation". In matters relating to the protection of your personal data, you can contact each of the Joint Controllers. We encourage you to read the detailed information on the principles of personal data processing:

#### **1. Joint controllers**

The Joint Controllers are:

1) SGH Warsaw School of Economics with its seat in Warsaw, al. Niepodległości 162, hereinafter referred to as Controller or SGH;

And

2) Konrad Adenauer Foundation with its seat in Warsaw, ul. J. Dabrowskiego 56, hereinafter referred to as FKA.

#### **2. Data Protection Officer**

The Joint Controllers have appointed Data Protection Officers who can be contacted:

#### **3. The purposes and legal basis of processing of personal data**

The personal data will be processed for the purpose of organizing the conference, ensuring the possibility of speaking at the conference, maintaining contact with you in connection with this conference, documenting its course and publishing a post-conference publication.

The legal basis for processing of personal data is point (e) of Art. 6 (1) GDPR<sup>1</sup> (necessity for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest) and The Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher

Education and Science (Journal of Laws [Dz.U.] of 2020 item 85) and, point (b) of Art. 6 (1) GDPR (processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract), in the case of a post-conference publication.

#### **4. Voluntary data provision**

Providing personal data is voluntary, however necessary to for the purposes mentioned above.

#### **5. The recipients or categories of recipients of the personal data**

If the controller uses the services of other entities, personal data may be disclosed to them on the basis of contracts entrusting them with the processing of personal data, and these entities will be obliged to preserve the confidentiality of the processed data.

#### **6. Automated individual decision-making, including profiling**

Your data will not undergo profiling and no automated decision-making will be conducted based on these data.

#### **7. The period for which the personal data will be processed**

Your personal data will be processing for the for the period necessary to organize the conference and then for the duration of storing of documentation for archival purposes. Personal data related to the post-conference publication will be processed for the time necessary for its issuing and during the time of publication.

#### **8. The rights of data subject**

You have the right to access and rectify and erase your data or restrict the processing thereof.

You have right to object to processing.

#### **9. The right to lodge a complaint**

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you consider that the processing of your personal data infringes upon GDPR.

Moreover, we would like to inform you that the conference may be recorded. Recorded speeches may be published on the websites of the joint controllers.
