

# Call for Participants (SummerLab: Games & Decisions 2019)

We are happy to announce a Call for Participants in the **SummerLab: Games & Decisions 2019** that takes place at the **SGH Warsaw School of Economics**, Warsaw, Poland, from **July 8 to July 19, 2019**.

The SummerLab is conducted by scholars from the partnering institutions:

- SGH Warsaw School of Economics,
- Faculty of Economics of the University of Porto,
- Faculty of Business, Economics and Law, the Queensland University.

The focus is on applications of game theory and decision theory to the analysis of the modern economy. The core of the classes consists of the following topics:

- Advances in Inductive Game Theory,
- Digital Economics: a Game Theoretical Analysis,
- Time (In)consistency and Costly Self-control,
- Range Effects for Decisions Under Risk and Time Delay,
- Theory of Markets with Asymmetric Information and Strategic Communication,
- Modelling Preferences for Health States to Support Public Decision Making.

Participants are expected to have an ongoing interest in game theory, especially in the academic context. The SummerLab is aimed at graduate students, but the recruitment process is also **open** to undergraduates, postdocs and professionals.

Due to financial support by **the Polish National Academic Exchange Agency (NAWA)**, participants are **not required to pay any fee for the participation** in the SummerLab. Budget accommodation and partial alimentation (three coffee breaks and a lunch on Monday-Friday) are also provided free of charge. The participants are expected to cover their travel costs and insurance fees.

The participants will be chosen based on submitted applications, with provided **declaration of interest in the topic of the SummerLab, hitherto academic achievements and proficiency in English** constituting the major criteria of selection.
